Eligibility Criteria for Participation

The project must be a final-year graduation project completed by 4th or 5th-year bachelor students.
All team members must be currently enrolled students at the university at the time of the competition.
The project must be completed within the current academic year.
The project must demonstrate original work and should not be copied or plagiarized.
The project must offer a solution or contribution that is relevant to the field of study.
The project must demonstrate a high level of creativity or innovative thinking
The project should reflect the students' own ideas and intellectual contributions, not a reproduction of existing work.
Use of unconventional or cross-disciplinary approaches will be considered an added value.
The project must demonstrate application of knowledge, theory, or practical skills gained through the academic program.
Projects must be safe, ethical, and comply with university or national regulations
The project should show evidence of research, design, and/or innovation.
Each team must be available to present their project during the competition
All required documents and materials must be submitted by the registration deadline.
The project must not have previously won prize in a national or international competition.
