National Workshop: KRG Anti-Corruption Strategy Plan

On December 11, 2024, the Law and International Relations and Diplomacy Departments at Tishk International University, in collaboration with the Stop Organization, organized a national workshop titled: "Assessing the KRG Anti-Corruption Strategy Plan for 2021-2025."

The workshop aimed to educate participants about the dangers of corruption and the Kurdistan Regional Government's efforts to combat it through its strategic anti-corruption plan. Mr. Badr Mohamad Taher served as the moderator and stated that the workshop was organized to celebrate this year's International Anti-Corruption Day, aligning with SDG 16: Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions.

The workshop featured two distinguished speakers:

Asst. Prof. Dr. Adnan Abdullah Rashid, Director General of the Office of Prevention and Transparency of the Board of Corruption, Kurdistan Regional Government.

Strengthening the legal framework for fighting corruption.


Educating the public about the dangers of corruption.
