(Make-up Examination and Summer School)

Information for Students

Dear students, with regard to the decision taken by the university council, summer term course rules have been newly due to scheduled make-up examinations. Along with the below-mentioned rules, new rules have been provided in the 'Student Handbook, 2025-2026, page 30, article 26. Please read the newly designed rules diligently.

Make-up Assessment

1- Depending on the results of the final exams (FALL and SPRING), failed students can participate in the final exams of summer school as a make-up examination.

2- Students are allowed to take make-up examinations of the course(s) in which they have failed the final examinations. Make-up examinations are held for the courses indicated below: Courses failed in FF, FD, DD- or DC-.

3- Students who failed with NA are not permitted to take make-up examinations and are required to take summer school courses.

4- Make-up examinations cannot be taken to increase the GPA.

5- Section A: Regulations for 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th-Grade Students

(Applicable to students who enrolled prior to the 2025-2026 Academic Year)

- The same achievement grading system used for final examinations applies to make-up exams.
- The score obtained in the make-up examination will replace the original final exam score and be accepted as the official grade.

- The make-up exam score will be included in the GPA calculation for the specific semester in which the student originally failed the course.
- The highest grade a student can achieve in a make-up examination is capped at CC.

Section B: Regulations for 1st-Grade Students

(Applicable to students who enrolled in the 2025-2026 Academic Year)

To be eligible to sit for a make-up examination, a student must meet the following criteria:

- If the student's pre-final score is not enough to obtain the passing mark in the make-up examination, the student cannot attend the make-up exam.
- The student must have completed all required coursework and strictly complied with the attendance and academic policies of TIU.
- Eligible students are permitted to take a maximum of four (4) make-up exams per academic year including the Fall and Spring semesters.
- The make-up grade will be counted as it is received.

6- If students wish to increase their GPA, they may register for Summer Term.

7- The make-up examination period will be held between August 11 - September 19, 2026. Summer term final examination and make-up examination will take place on the same days.

8- Students are responsible for following make-up examination dates at a specified date(s) by the departments.

9- In make-up assessment, any excuse(s) (medical report, permission, etc) are not valid.

10- All passing grades, attendance rules, and disciplinary rules will be applied according to the 'Undergraduate Education and Examination Regulations and Disciplinary Rules of TIU.

11- The make-up examination schedule will be announced once the summer term begins.

12- Students willing to take make-up examinations only must register their names in their departments.

Important Notes

1. Students who have failed courses FF, FD, DD-, DC-, or due to attendance (NA) may be required to attend summer term courses. Nevertheless, attendance and payment are compulsory. In the summer term, students are allowed the utmost four courses (course hours are given twice as much as credit; for instance, a course with three credits will be taught 6 hours a week).
2. A course will be opened in the summer term on the condition that a minimum of four students enrol. Students will pay 120 000 IQD per credit for courses.
3. Educational term for the summer term is (1+5) 6 weeks. The first five weeks include summer term mid-term and other exams. 6th week is the period for final exams.
4. For further details, please contact the head of your department.
5. All passing grades, attendance rules, and disciplinary rules will be applied according to the 'Undergraduate Education and Examination Regulations and Disciplinary Rules of Tishk International University.
6. Students must complete pre-registration through SIS before registering for the summer term.
7. Summer term registration process will be implemented through the SIS system (as in other semesters).
8. Academic Calendar for Summer School and Make-up Examination Period.
